ABOUT TIRUNELVELI

Tirunelveli, also known as Nellai and historically Tinnevely, is a city in the south Indian State of Tamil Nadu formed in the year 1790. The word Tirunelveli is derived from three Tamil words: Thiru-Nel-Veli (Thiru - Shri, Nel = Paddy, Veli = Fence). It is believed that food grains collected for the worship at the temple were protected from the floods by the fence, hence the name Nel Velicame. The city is located in the west bank of the Thamirabarani River; its twin city Palayamkottai on the east bank. The city is an educational hub of southern Tamilnadu, referred as "Oxford of South India". The district is one of the major producers of wind energy in the country. Tirunelveli is well connected by road and rail with the rest of the Tamil Nadu and by rail with major Indian cities like Bengaluru, Mumbai, Trivandrum and Delhi. The nearest airport to Tirunelveli are Tuticorin (35kms), Madurai (150kms) and Trivandrum (145kms) away. The nearby worth seeing places are Swamy Nellaiappar temple, Courtallam waterfalls (55kms), Kanyakumari (80Kms), Tiruchendur (50kms) and Kalakad Mundanthurai Tiger Reserve (45Kms). The college campus is approximately 6 km away from the Tirunelveli Railway station and the old bus stand.

ABSTRACTS

Abstracts of the scientific/research/clinical papers relevant to the scientific sessions are invited for oral/poster presentations. The abstract of papers should be based on the original work of the authors and must not have been published elsewhere. Abstracts not exceeding 250 words (Times New Roman, Font size-12, single space in editable MS word format) should be uploaded on the conference website **www.isvmconferences.com**. The name of the presenting author must be underlined in the abstract. The last date for abstract submission is 15th December, 2016. The papers for presentation at the conference will be considered only if the presenting author register himself/herself for the conference on or before 15th December, 2016. Only original and quality papers will be accepted and selected research papers will be considered for oral/poster presentation in the relevant technical session. The communication regarding acceptance of the paper will be sent to the corresponding author by email only.

ACCOMMODATION

Accommodation for delegates will be arranged in private hotels/guest houses in Tirunelveli at their own cost. Tariff begins from Rs. 750 per day per person to Rs. 2000 per day per person (on share basis in double occupancy). Those who require accommodation are requested to pay an advance of Rs 2000 along with registration fees on or before 15th December, 2016. Otherwise, the accommodation will be taken care of them. The students registered by the key date will be considered for dormitory accommodation at nominal cost.
